As required by the New York State General Municipal Law, the Village of North Syracuse hereby notifies you of a pending project that is located within 500' of the municipal border of the Village of North Syracuse, and Town of Cicero.

Please be advised under the Village of North Syracuse Code, the property located at 413 Church St. (Tax ID. No. 022.-02-01.2) known as North Area Meals On Wheels, which is zoned R-9 (Residential). Applicant is proposing to install 232 ground mounted solar arrays, in 4 rows surrounded with a wire mesh fence to cover approximately 14,000 ft², to be installed in the empty ball field behind their building between Rt. 81 and Sleeth Park.

The Village Planning Commission shall conduct a meeting to review the proposed Site Plan for the 14,000 ft², ground mounted solar array on September 18th, 2025 commencing at 5:30 PM and to be held at the North Syracuse Community Center at the corner of South Bay Road and Centerville Place in the Village, unless otherwise specified.
